
Minutes of the Renal Transplant Consultants Meeting held on 13.02.2021

- Adhar card must for Indian recipients.
- Donor below 60yr - Recipient below 60yr - no recipient - above 60yr of same zone.
- Medical reports while giving donor alert.
- Paediatric age 12 year.
- Marginal kidney acceptance letter.
- When no hospital is willing to accept no takers kidney, then both kidneys can be allocated to a single recipient if requested for by a hospital.


